in earlier times for the chinese korea was the country of courteous people from the east and for westerners the land of the morning calm or hermit kingdom in this fascinating collection of writings on times past in korea the author helps to lift the veil on this once closed country providing the reader with a wide selection of first hand accounts by travellers who discovered korea some as snapshots by those passing through others more detailed evaluations of korean culture and everyday life by those who spent time there the collection covers a period of over 400 years from hendrik hamel s journal of the 1600s to early 20th century records such as roy c andrew s 1918 published account of his expedition entitled exploring unknown corners of the hermit kingdom this volume critically examines sources of evidence and material from the archive that historically have been used to tell southern africa s pre colonial story this collection of translated tales is from the most famous work in all of japanese classical literature the konjaku monogatari shu this collection of traditional japanese folklore is akin to the canterbury tales of chaucer or dante s inferno powerfully entertaining tales that reveal striking aspects of the cultural psychology fantasy and creativity of medieval japan tales that still resonate with modern japanese readers today the ninety stories in this book are filled with keen psychological insights wry sarcasm and scarcely veiled criticisms of the clergy nobles and peasants alike suggesting that there are among all classes and peoples similar failings of pride vanity superstition and greed as well as aspirations toward higher moral goals this is the largest collection in english of the konjaku monogatari shu tales ever published in one volume it presents the low life and the high life the humble and the devout the profane flirting farting and fornicating of everyday men and women as well as their yearning for the wisdom transcendence and compassion that are all part and parcel of our shared humanity stories include the grave of chopsticks robbers come to a temple and steal its bell the woman fish peddler at the guardhouse fish are turned into the lotus sutra a dragon is caught by a tengu goblin the monk tojo predicts the fall of shujaku gate wasps attack a spider in revenge in this extraordinary work donald j wilcox seeks to discover an approach to narrative and history consistent with the discontinuous relative time of the twentieth century he shows how our b c a d system intimately connected to newtonian concepts of continuous objective and absolute time has affected our conception and experience of the past he demonstrates absolute time s centrality to modern historical methodologies and the problems it has created in the selection and interpretation of facts inspired by contemporary fiction and einsteinian concepts of relativity he concludes his analysis with a comparison of our system with earlier pre newtonian time schemes to create a radical new critique of historical objectivity a fascinating and colourful social history of the nighttime a wonderful revelation of a
