suitable for researchers policy makers organisations and companies as well as for
those with an interest in the identification and promotion of good practice within an
ageing society machine learning builds models of the world using training data from
the application domain and prior knowledge about the problem the models are later

mechanisms of the production of choir stalls the conference dealt with basic

The book moves with progressively challenging projects from loose wildflower meadows textured woodland and rustic rambling walls to atmospheric or semi abstract landscape corners all rendered in Ann's adventurous signature style. Loose expressive mark making and unusual techniques include combining water based paint and ink with granulation medium for dramatic texture drawing with twigs using gesso and collage to create unique effects manipulating paint with materials such as plastic wrap clingfilm developing printed marks made using found materials. Following the huge demand for more practical guidance in experimental painting the book provides plenty of techniques and instruction. Ann's personal commentary also gives a unique insight into the mind of the artist ways of looking at your subject how to explore and experiment to unlock the potential of your watercolour painting.

Nine summer fusion science research workshops for minority and female high school students were conducted at the Hampton University Center for Fusion Research and Training from 1996 to 2005. Each workshop was of the duration of eight weeks. In all 35 high school students were mentored. The students presented 28 contributed papers at the annual meetings of the American Physical Society Division of Plasma Physics. These contributed papers were very well received by the plasma physics and fusion science research community. The students won a number of prestigious local state and national honors awards prizes and scholarships. The notable among these are the two regional finalist positions in the 1999 Siemens Westinghouse Science and Technology competitions 1st place U.S. Army award 2006 1st place U.S. Naval Science Award 2006 Yale Science and Engineering Association Best 11th grade project 2006 Society of Physics Students Book Award 2006 APS Corporate Minority Scholarship and others. This workshop program conducted by the HUCFRT has been an exemplary success and served the minority and female students exceptionally fruitfully. The summer high school fusion science workshop is an immensely successful outreach activity conducted by the HUCFRT. In this workshop we train motivate and provide high quality research experiences to young and talented high school scholars with emphasis on under represented minorities and female students in fusion science and related areas. The purpose of this workshop is to expose minority and female students to the excitement of research in science at an early stage in their academic lives. It is our hope that this may lead the high school students to pursue higher education and careers in physical sciences mathematics and perhaps in fusion science. To our knowledge this workshop is the first and only one to date of fusion science for under

represented minorities and female high school students at an hbcu the faculty researchers in the hu cfrt mentor the students during summers mentors spend a considerable amount of time and efforts in training teaching guiding and supervising research projects the hu cfrt has so far conducted nine workshops during the summers of 1996 2000 and 2002 2005 the first workshop was conducted in summer 1996 students for the workshop are chosen from a national pool of exceptionally talented high school rising seniors juniors to our knowledge most of these students have gone on to prestigious universities such as duke university john hopkins university caltech ucla hampton university etc after completing their high school for instance tiffany fisher participant of the 1996 summer workshop completed her bs in mathematics at hampton university in may 2001 she then went on to wake forest university at winston salem north carolina to pursue graduate studies anshul haldipur participant of the 1999 summer workshop began his undergraduate studies at duke university in 2000 christina nguyen and ilissa martinez participants of the 2000 summer workshop are pursuing their undergraduate degrees at the ucla and florida state university respectively the organizing committee of the aps dpp annual meeting invited dr punjabi to deliver an invited talk on training the next generation of fusion scientists and engineers at the 2005 aps dpp meeting in denver co the organizing committee distributed a special flier with the bulletin to highlight this invited talk and another talk on education as well the expo this has given wide publicity and recognition to our workshops and hampton university prof punjabi s talk li2 2 training the next generation of fusion scientists and engineers summer high school fusion science workshop bull amer phys soc 50 221 2005 was very well received he talked about hu education and outreach initiative and the hu cfrt summer high school workshop the audience had a considerable number of questions about our workshops and the high school to phd pipeline in fusion science professor william mathews of university of delaware offered to give the hu team mhd codes to use and professor birdsall of university of california berkeley plasma theory and simulation group offered to give the team simple simulation codes to use we are very happy and proud and very gratified by this and we thank the us doe ofes dr sam barish and dr michael crisp for their support and encouragement this two volume set lncs 4277 4278 constitutes the refereed proceedings of 14 international workshops held as part of otm 2006 in montpellier france in october november 2006 the 191 revised full papers presented were carefully reviewed and selected from a total of 493 submissions to the workshops the first volume begins with 26 additional revised short or poster papers of the otm 2006 main conferences an eye opening examination of latin america s role as proving ground for u s imperial strategies and tactics in recent years one book after another has sought to take the measure of the bush administration s aggressive foreign policy in their search for precedents they invoke the roman and british empires as well as postwar reconstructions of germany and japan yet they consistently ignore the one place where the united states had its most formative imperial experience latin america a brilliant excavation of a long

Obscured History: Empire's Workshop is the first book to show how Latin America has functioned as a laboratory for American extraterritorial rule. Historian Greg Grandin follows the United States imperial operations from Thomas Jefferson's aspirations for an Empire of Liberty in Cuba and Spanish Florida to Ronald Reagan's support for brutally oppressive but U.S. friendly regimes in Central America. He traces the origins of Bush's policies to Latin America where many of the administration's leading lights, John Negroponte, Elliott Abrams, and Otto Reich, first embraced the deployment of military power to advance free market economics and first enlisted the evangelical movement in support of their ventures. With much of Latin America now in open rebellion against U.S. domination, Grandin concludes with a vital question: if Washington has failed to bring prosperity and democracy to Latin America, its own backyard workshop, what are the chances it will do so for the world?

In 2008, the Computer and Information Science and Engineering Directorate of the National Science Foundation asked the National Research Council (NRC) to conduct two workshops to explore the nature of computational thinking and its cognitive and educational implications. The first workshop focused on the scope and nature of computational thinking and on articulating what computational thinking for everyone might mean. A report of that workshop was released in January 2010. Drawing in part on the proceedings of that workshop, *Report of a Workshop of Pedagogical Aspects of Computational Thinking* summarizes the second workshop, which was held February 4-5, 2010, in Washington, D.C., and focuses on pedagogical considerations for computational thinking. This workshop was structured to gather pedagogical inputs and insights from educators who have addressed computational thinking in their work with K-12 teachers and students. It illuminates different approaches to computational thinking and explores lessons learned and best practices. Individuals with a broad range of perspectives contributed to this report. Since the workshop was not intended to result in a consensus regarding the scope and nature of computational thinking, *Report of a Workshop of Pedagogical Aspects of Computational Thinking* does not contain findings or recommendations. This book contains the final reports of 19 workshops held during the 20th European Conference on Object-Oriented Programming (ECOOP 2006) held in Nantes, France, in July 2006. The 19 reports cover the entire range of object technology and related topics, presenting a coherent and highly representative snapshot of the major trends in the field. Parallel and distributed processing, although within the focus of computer science research for a long time, is gaining more and more importance in a wide spectrum of applications. These proceedings aim to demonstrate the use of parallel and distributed processing concepts in different application fields and attempt to spark interest in novel research directions to advance the embracing model of high performance computing. Research in general, the objective of these workshops is to specifically address researchers coming from university, industry, and governmental research organizations and application-oriented companies in order to close the gap between purely scientific research and the applicability of the research ideas to real life.

problems euro par is an annual series of international conferences dedicated to the promotion and advancement of all aspects of parallel and distributed computing the 2007 event was the 13th issue of the conference euro par has for a long time been eager to attract colocated events sharing the same goal of promoting the development of parallel and distributed computing both as an industrial technique and an academic discipline extending the frontier of both the state of the art and the state of the practice since 2006 euro par offers researchers the chance to colocate advanced technical workshops back to back with the main conference this is for a mutual benefit the workshops can take advantage of all technical and social facilities which are set up for the conference so that the organizational tasks are kept to a minimal level the conference can rely on workshops to experiment with specific areas of research which are not yet mature enough or too specific to lead to an official full edged topic at the conference radio technologies and concepts for imt advanced presents the findings of the wireless world initiative new radio winner project in framework program 6 of the european commission it provides an insight into the key concepts and technologies for the imt advanced radio interface based on the collaborative research of manufacturers network operators research centres and universities within winner the book covers the fundamental radio characteristics of a typical 4g wireless communication system focusing on the transceiver's chain from the physical layer to layers 2 and 3 starting by defining realistic and futuristic usage scenarios the authors provide in depth discussion of key technologies including modulation and coding link level procedures spatial temporal processing multiple access schemes and inter cell interference mitigation channel estimation and newly developed channel models finally a cost assessment and optimisation methodology is developed for different deployment concepts in order to assess a wireless system in a condition close to reality the book provides an important system level approach to the latest radio technologies in the field and evaluates imt advanced research in relation to international standardisation presents the research findings of imt advanced radio interface from the winner project covers the latest concepts for relaying multiple access radio resource control flexible spectrum use and itur spectrum demand calculation examines the most recent multiple input multiple output mimo techniques and distributed antenna systems coordinated multipoint transmissions describes a 4g system concept and all major building blocks provides 4g propagation models and system level evaluation methodologies this is a book for low budgets and high ambition read it and you will learn how to put images of things onto other things you will start by rolling up your sleeves your shirt will be stained anyways at some point you will harness the power of the sun go ahead look inside you will see that you do not need a fancy studio to print a t shirt or a picnic blanket there is no specialized machine required to print anything you want in any room you want a mural a dartboard a deck of cards these are all possible in a week or a month you will wake up to find you know words like acetate and substrate you will be comfortable talking about ink and shopping at military supply stores perhaps most
